Have you heard of Early Intervention?

- Early Intervention supports families with children birth to age three who have developmental delays or disabilities so they have the best possible start in life.
- The program can help determine if there is a concern or not.
- There is no need to “wait and see.”
- The earlier we start the process with your child, the better.

Why Early Intervention?

- There is no “downside” to referring a child. Screening and eligibility determination are free.
- Early support can reduce the need for services later in life.
- It is an evidence-based approach designed to help your child.
- It supports your entire family.
- Services are provided where families live, play, and spend their day.

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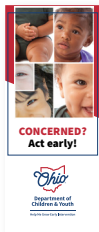
