Questionnaires® to understand your child's development.




Get inspired to learn together through play. Library of offscreen activities to grow children's hearts, words, minds, and bodies!

Download the app to your smartphone or tablet.


Go to the App Store or Google Play Store and download the app. You can search for the app or find it by scanning the QR code below.

Tap on "Email address" or another method to create your new account.



This will connect you with your school or program.



Now it's time to set up the parent or caregiver's Sparkler account.


- Enter your email address and create a password you'll remember.
- Press next.
- On the following screen, enter your name and contact information.







Set up your child's profile.



- Start with 1 child, between birth and age 5. You can add siblings later!
- The most important thing to share on this screen is your child's correct birth date (and weeks prematurity if your child is under 2 years old).
- The birth date allows Sparkler to assign the correct play content and developmental screening.



You'll see the names of the organizations that are "Sponsoring Partners."

These are the organizations that are supporting you with Sparkler. They'll be able to see your screening results and play/engagement in order to offer support.
